

The Fae nation of Britannia is composed of 3 kingdoms: Albion, Caledonia and Cymru.

The kingdom of Cymru is ruled by King Dafydd ap Gywdion and Queen Rhiannon ap Gywidon ne Fiona.

The city of Cardiff is also known as the Duchy of Tiger Bay, ruled by Duchess Evangeline ne Dougal.

Within the Duchy are several major fiefdoms:

Fief of Blackweir: In the northeastern metro area, comprised of the mortal districts of Cathays, Roath and Heath, the Fief of Blackweir home to much of Cardiff's lively student population as well as many Seelie Commoners.

Fief of Llandaff: Running adjacent to the river Taff in the northwest are the mortal districts of Pontcanna and Llandaff, leafy suburbs with a bohemian feel which are home to some of Cardiff's more creative industries including the BBC Wales site.

Fief of Treganna: West of the city center and across the river Taff are Riverside and Canton, areas with a vibrant multicultural feel that has become a haven for those Unseelie Commoners displaced from Tiger Bay.

Fief of Stone Court: Comprised of mortal areas such as Cyncoed, Radyr and Lisvane, this upper class fiefdom is home to both Seelie and Unseelie Sidhe, including much of the nobility from the court of Tiger Bay.

Along the coast to the west is the mortal city of Swansea, known by Changelings as the **Duchy of Copperopolis**. As a Welsh center for culture and the arts the city attracts many Changelings and thus maintains close diplomatic ties with Tiger Bay.

Prominent members of Duchess Evangeline's royal court include:

Sir Beagan ap Gwydion, Lord Chancellor: the Duchess's right hand man and, as some would have it, the de facto ruler of Tiger Bay. The late Duke Stephen is said to have saved this Sidhe knight's life, and he serves the Duchess in an attempt to repay that debt.

Sir Callum ap Liam, Chamberlain: keeper of the Duchess's household and once a political force to be reckoned with, this Sidhe grump has fallen out of favor with the court.

Prince Colin ap Dougal, Heir Apparent: in the absence of a blood relative, the childling Colin has become Evangeline's protege and is expected to succeed her one day. He has lived a sheltered life almost entirely within the freeholds of the court, and thus his aging has become somewhat regressed.

Baroness Meredydd ne Eiluned, Mistress of the Exchequer: a rising star in Duchess Evangeline's court, there are rumors linking the Lady Meredydd to the Unseelie population of Tiger Bay. Some even whisper that she has dealings with the so-called Shadow Court.

Shar, Court Magician: not much is known about this reclusive fox pooka; few have met her in person, and even the name Shar may just be an invention of the court gossips. She has reportedly been granted a title by the nobility of House Eiluned.

Sir Ulfr Sigurbjornsson, Constable: a troll Wilder too young to have participated in the Accordance War, this bellicose giant is eager for the opportunity to prove himself and thus something of a war hawk at court.
